

LAMDA classes

The London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art (LAMDA) is the oldest drama examining board in the United Kingdom and examinations are designed to equip candidates, whatever their age and aspirations, with a range of skills that will serve them throughout life.

Preparation for the exam can unlock the imagination, develop communication skills, refine artistry and develop self-confidence.

The weekly classes will follow a simple format. This will include vocal techniques and exercises, quick thinking exercises, colouring of words, mime, actions, specific games, tongue twisters and memorising. These classes, which will be geared towards taking examinations, will be small group lessons of 45 minutes. (maximum 6 children)

These classes will start after half term with the first lesson commencing at 6pm.
